Programme Introduction:

In order to enhance the professional competitiveness of students in the financial professional field, we successfully organized the International Competence Enhancement Programme (ICEP) consisting of professional competency-based courses and internship in international multilateral organization projects in Germany (August 11-24, 2019) with the participation of 10 students and 2 lecturers from your institution. As the second term of our cooperation, 24 students from your institution participated the online version of ICEP last year (August 03-14, 2020). The feedback was extremely positive. This year, we will also provide the online version of ICEP (August 02-13. 2021) for our third term of cooperation. The 2-weeks' curricula and internship will be implemented remotely using popular online-conference platform/facility.
