Programme Introduction:

In order to enhance the professional competitiveness of students in the financial professional field, we successfully organized the International Competence Enhancement Programme (ICEP) consisting of professional competency-based courses and internship in international multilateral organization projects in Germany (August 11-24, 2019) with the participation of 10 students and 2 lecturers from your institution.
