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### **Invited Speakers**



#### Xiwen Chen

is Chairman of Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee of the National People's Congress and Chief Economist of National Agricultural and Rural Development Research Institute, China Agricultural University. He formerly held office as deputy head of the Central Leading Group for Rural Work and director of its working office. He is one of the major contributors in drafting some of the vital documents guiding rural reform and development that have been issued by the CPC Central Committee and the State Council since 1983. As the leader of the drafting team, he participated in drafting the annual No. 1 Central Document from 2004 to 2016, the reports delivered at the 17th and 18th CPC National Congress, and the various decisions and recommendations issued at the plenary sessions of the CPC Central Committee. He has been awarded China's Sun Yefang Economic Science Award on four occasions.



### Johan Swinnen

is Director General of the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) and Global Director of the Systems Transformation Science Group at CGIAR. Prior to joining IFPRI, Dr. Swinnen was professor and director of the LICOS Centre at KU Leuven (Belgium) and senior research fellow at the Centre for European Policy Studies.Dr. Swinnen earned his PhD from Cornell University and holds honorary doctorates from University of Göttingen and the Slovak University of Agriculture (Slovakia). He is a Fellow of the Agricultural & Applied Economics Association and the European Association of Agricultural Economists and served as president of the International Association of Agricultural Economists from 2012 to 2015.Dr. Swinnen has published extensively, and is widely cited, on agricultural and food policies, international development, political economy, institutional reforms, trade, and global value chains.



### **Kym Anderson**

is George Gollin Professor Emeritus in the School of Economics and Public Policy at the University of Adelaide (where he has been affiliated since 1984) and an Honorary Professor at the Australian National University's Crawford School of Public Policy (where he was a Research Fellow 1977-83 and a part-time Professor of Economics 2012-18). In two periods of extended leave he served as deputy head of economic research at the GATT Secretariat (now World Trade Organization) in Geneva (1990-92) and as Lead Economist (Trade Policy) at the World Bank in Washington DC (2004-07). During 2010-17 he served on the Board of Trustees of the International Food Policy Research Institute (Washington DC), chairing it from 2015. Since doctoral studies at the University of Chicago and Stanford University, he has published more than 400 articles and 40 books. He is a recipient of an Honorary Doctor of Economics degree from the University of Adelaide and a Distinguished Alumni Award from the University of New England. In 2015 he became a Companion of the Order of Australia (AC).



### William A. Masters

is a Professor of Food Economics and Policy at Tufts University, in the Friedman School of Nutrition with a secondary appointment in the Department of Economics. From 2011 to 2014 he served as chair of the Friedman School's Department of Food and Nutrition Policy, and before coming to Tufts was a faculty member in Agricultural Economics at Purdue University (1991-2010), and also at the University of Zimbabwe (1989-90), Harvard's Kennedy School of Government (2000) and Columbia University (2003-04). He is the co-author of an undergraduate textbook, Economics of Agricultural Development: World Food Systems and Resource Use (Routledge, 4th ed. 2021), and former editor-in-chief of the journal Agricultural Economics (2006-2011). He was an elected a Fellow of the Agricultural and Applied Economics Association (AAEA) in 2020, and was previously awarded the AAEA's Bruce Gardner Memorial Prize for Applied Policy Analysis (2013) as well as the AAEA Publication of Enduring Quality Award (2014) and Quality of Research Discovery Award (2019).



### Shenggen Fan

is Chair Professor at China Agricultural University (CAU). Prior to joining CAU, Shenggen Fan was director general of the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) from 2009 to 2019. Dr. Fan joined IFPRI in 1995 as a research fellow, conducting extensive research on pro-poor development strategies in Africa, Asia, and the Middle East. He led IFPRI's program on public investment before becoming the director of the Institute's Development Strategy and Governance Division in 2005. He served as member, vice chair and chair of the World Economic Forum's Global Agenda Council on Food and Nutrition Security. Dr. Fan was awarded an honorary life member of the International Association of Agricultural Economists (IAAE) in 2018, and became Fellow of American Applied Economics Association (AAEA) in 2020.In 2014, Dr. Fan received the Hunger Hero Award from the World Food Programme in recognition of his commitment to and leadership in fighting hunger worldwide. Dr. Fan received a PhD in applied economics from the University of Minnesota and bachelor's and master's degrees from Nanjing Agricultural University in China.
